

# Behaviour for Learning – Shared Expectations

# A Summary of Expectations for all:

- ✓ These expectations apply to all students, at all times and are NOT negotiable
- ✓ Each student can EXPECT to receive recognition, Awards and Rewards when they follow these
- ✓ If all follow these expectations, school will be a place where respect for all is clear and Learning can take priority – CONSISTENCY is the key

### General behaviour

- Being on time for school is necessary every day and every lesson
- Students who are late will make up lost learning time in catch up either at lunchtime or in after school detentions (period 7).
- Corridors need to be calm and safe for all Duties must be done and behaviour must be sensible
- All should keep to the LEFT on corridors
- Food should only be consumed in the canteens and outside all litter needs to put into a bin
- Running, pushing or other dangerous behaviour is not allowed in corridors it is not SAFE

### Uniform:

- A school skirt or trousers not skinny jeans
- A school jumper this must be worn every day
- A school Tie appropriate for your year group, worn properly
- A shirt with a top button that fastens
- A suitable warm coat to wear when travelling to and from school not to be worn at all times, and removed when in class WITHOUT argument
- All black shoes NOT black with pattern or with coloured aspects
- Students are not allowed to bring any current fashion into our uniform
- Socks should be black or grey
- No jewellery apart from small stud earrings and a watch
- No other facial piercings
- Discrete make up only no false eyelashes or eyebrows

## Other Expectations:

- All students must bring all necessary equipment every day, including a journal.
  Mobile phones <u>must not</u> be seen or used in corridors or classrooms
- If a mobile phone is seen it will be confiscated by a member of staff
- High sugar/ Energy drinks are BANNED they will be confiscated
- Smoking is banned everywhere on our school site

Our school sanctions apply to ALL students if they fail to follow expectations

Consistency from all staff at all times is the key to this having the maximum impact across school
